Luke 19:28-44

Preparation of His Arrival v.28-35

“When He had said this, He went on ahead going up to Jerusalem.”

- **Jesus prepared His friends.**
- **Jesus prepared to fulfill prophecy.**

Praise of His Arrival v.35-38

Jesus was treated like a king.

- **The people acted as if He were a king.**
- **The people glorified Him as king.**

Perplexity of His Arrival v.39-40

The Pharisees did not know what to do.

- They lost power over the people.
- Their hatred was getting them nowhere. (19:14, John 12:19)

Plight of His Arrival v.41-44

Jesus wept.

- **Jesus knew the people did not understand the meaning of this day.**
- **Jesus knew the judgment that was to come to Jerusalem.**

- **How do I treat Jesus in my daily life?**
- **Does His arrival “perplex” me?**
- **Do I weep over the lost? ... because I know judgment comes?**
