“Do not lead us into temptation ...”

- Does God cause us to sin? lead us into temptation? No! - James 1:13
- God only leads in His perfect path.
Psalm 5:8, 27:11, 139:24

“but deliver us from the evil one”

I Corinthians 10:13

Deliverance includes knowing ...

- God is faithful
- that it is not too much for me to handle
- God will provide the way of escape
- God will provide the grace to endure

How do I avoid falling to temptation?

- Recognize my tendency to sin – James 1:14
- Pray – Matthew 26:41
- Run – I Corinthians 6:18, 10:14, James 4:7
- Resist following the crowd – Matthew 26:35
- Stay busy in God's work – Ephesians 5:15-16
- Refocus with praise – Psalm 147
- Strengthen self with the "Truth" – Hebrews 4:12, II Corinthians 10:4-5, Ephesians 6:17
