Life Question



**Why do people,
especially believers,
suffer affliction?**

Purpose of the Blindness v.1-5



It presented an opportunity ...

- To make Him known in the midst of the affliction.
- For Jesus to teach the principle of urgency in spite of the affliction.

Power in the Healing v.6-7



- Jesus was not limited by the physical laws. (i.e. walking on water, water to wine)
- Obedience led to genuine saving faith. Romans 1:5, 15:18, 16:25, Hebrews 5:9

Point of the Healing v.8-11, 35-38



- The healing got the attention of others.
- The healing caused others to ask questions.
- The healing made Jesus known.
- Jesus brought the man to saving faith.

Applications



1. Ask God, “Lord, what opportunities are You putting before me as I go through this affliction?”
2. Bless others in your suffering.
3. Share your story with the “blind beggars” around you.
4. Believe God for the supernatural.
