**Bible:** Spiral Notebooks (a 2<sup>nd</sup> may be needed later in the year if they run out of space)  
New King James Version Bible (strongly recommended for memorization)  
Composition Book for Journal

**English:** 1" binder 5 dividers  
1 Composition notebook 1 pk 3" x 5" index cards

**History:** 1" binder 5 dividers  
Post-it notes 2- or 3- subject spiral notebook

**Math:** 1" binder TI-30XA calculator  
Clear Protractor Graph Paper  
Ruler with in. and cm. Spiral notebook with at least 100 pages (6<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> only)

**Science:** 1" binder 3 dividers  
2 spiral notebooks (7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup>)

## **General Supplies (to be replenished as needed throughout the year):**

1. 1" binder for agenda, optional
2. Blue or black ink pens, red pens, highlighters, and colored pencils
3. 1 pack of loose-leaf notebook paper in each binder
4. #2 pencils (mechanical preferred)
5. White out (tape, not liquid), optional
6. **Backpack must be able to go in student locker (Locker size 34"H x 10"W x 12"D)**
7. Combination Lock **REQUIRED** (Master Lock recommended, must be numerical – not key or arrows)
8. Metal Locker shelving recommended
9. Clear contact paper to cover textbooks
10. 1 GB flash drive for computer use on projects, optional
