Romans 3:23

- All have sinned.
- No one can satisfy God's standard.

Romans 6:23a

- There is a price to be paid for sin ...
DEATH!
- Death is physical and spiritual.
- Possibly explain the Garden (Paradise).

Romans 5:8

- God demonstrates His love.
Commendeth = showed, demonstrated
- He sent Christ to experience “death” for sin on our behalf.
- The Father sent the Son even though we were sinners.

Romans 6:23b

- Explain the difference between a wage and a gift.
- What is God's gift to us?
- In whom is that gift found?

Romans 10:9-10

- “Confess with your mouth ...Believe in your heart ...”
- Two truths to be believed:
 - Jesus as Lord
 - God raised Jesus from the dead

Romans 10:9-10

Two aspects of God's redemptive grace:

- 1. Confession → Salvation (negative)**
- 2. Belief → Righteousness (positive)**

Romans 10:9-10

Righteousness

- What we become
- Grace/life given
- Enter blessing
- Justification

Salvation

- What we escape
- Mercy/death w/held
- Escape cursing
- Propitiation
