Three \$200 Scholarship Drawings

Referrals (Receive a \$100 Tuition Credit for each family you refer & they enroll.)

For any new family enrolling because of your recommendation, you will receive a \$100 tuition credit next October. The new family will need to attach a referral form to their application and follow through with the enrollment. Two referral forms were included in the enrollment packets, and extras are always available in the office.

Important Note to Current Families:

We will not be able to place your child's name on the roster for next year if you have a past-due balance from 2017-2018. Please bring your account current to avoid that situation.




