Put a smile on your face, it's picture time! Don't forget to send your orders in when you receive them.

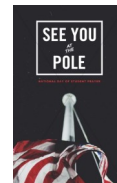


Thursday, Sept. 19, 4-6:30 pm **Conference Night**

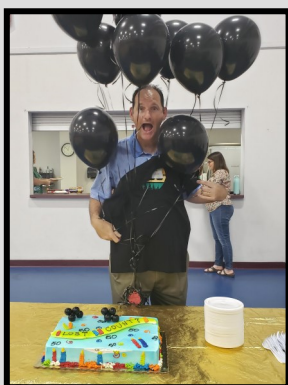
Book Fee Reminder . . .

If you did not pay your student's book fee in advance, please be aware that book fees for all grades are due by September 15.

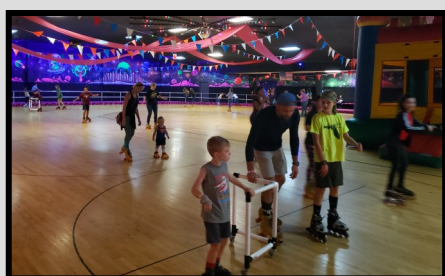
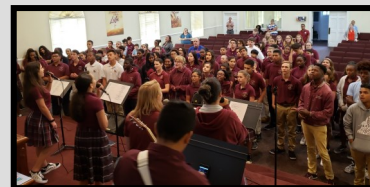
Welcome to Our New & Returning Students & Families!
