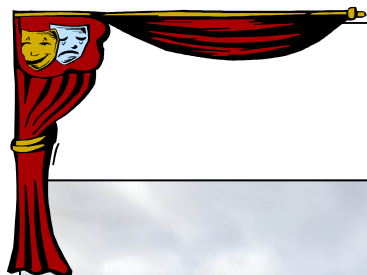
Field Day/Half Day: Friday, April 13

Parents, if you can volunteer to help, please let them know.

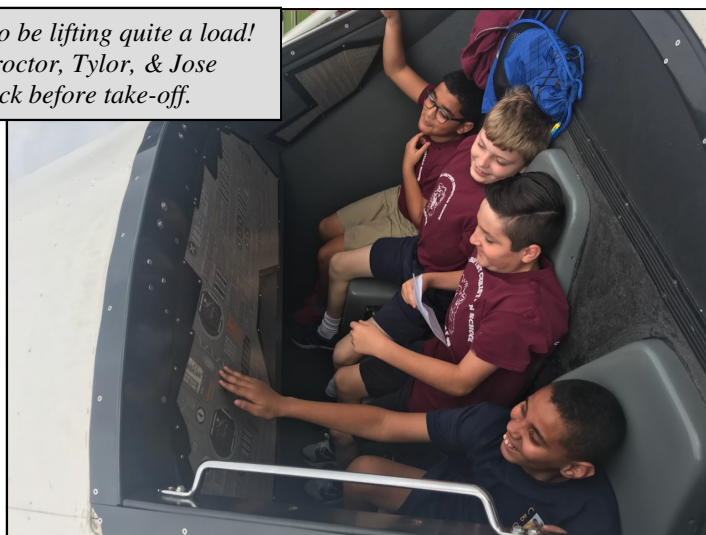

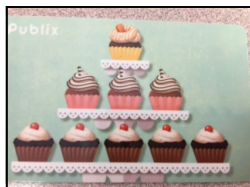
Mrs. Craven's Scrip News
