1. The Situation's Importance v.1-5

- Event's Importance - a wedding v.1
- Problem's Importance - no wine v.3
- Relational Importance - a relational shift between Jesus and Mary v.4

2. The Supply's Sufficiency v.6-10

- The supply was more than enough to meet the need. v.6-7
- The supply was the best that was offered. v.9-10

problem.



3. The Supply's Significance v.11

- This begins His walk to the cross.
- Jesus makes His deity known.
- People begin to believe.



John 20:30-31
